IN LAYMANS TERMS

Hello Everyone!

Alyssa and I wanted to write you all to thank you for your love, support and prayers, and to give you an update on what's been going on in her world of medications, doctors and tests. So prepare yourself!

First, the bad news. As many of you know back in September 2015, Alyssa, Terri (Alyssa's mom) and I flew to Washington D.C. for Alyssa to have a major surgery. One of the only doctors in America who could do the surgery laparoscopically corrected Alyssa's MALS. (MALS is an extremely rare defect where a ligament along the spine is crimping the main artery to the stomach, causing stomach paralysis, pain, nausea, extreme food sensitivity and other symptoms.) After surgery, Alyssa received a boost for a few months with less nausea, occasionally even able to eat raw vegetables like salads again. But the past few months, her stomach has digressed to where she can barely eat and has extreme stomach pain. This week Alyssa had tests in Dallas that did not return the results we were hoping for. Her MALS has grown back and returned to the level of compression it was at pre-surgery. We were also told she has a similar condition compressing her left renal vein that goes to her kidney (Nutcracker Syndrome). From what we have heard so far, if she has to have surgery again it would most likely need to be an open procedure. It would be devastating if Alyssa needs open surgery because of the fragility of her body overall and her EDS connective tissue disorder that affects wound healing ability. We will learn more & explore our options over time.

Now for the GOOD news! Alyssa's doctor in Florida who has been treating her since January tested Alyssa's CD57 levels (an immune marker for Lyme Disease). A normal person's counts are in the 100's, while someone with severe Lyme Disease like Alyssa will be very low with numbers in the teens-twenties (which is exactly where Alyssa has been for the past four years in spite of various treatments). Her latest test revealed a CD57 increase from 29 to 70!!! That is HUGE! She also saw progress with her C-Reactive Protein inflammation marker decreasing from 12 to 1.4. Her doctors (as are we) are very excited with these results! It shows that Alyssa's treatments are WORKING and she is progressing with numbers to prove it. It is so encouraging to know, especially while she actually feels worse instead of better during this portion of treatment. God is working in and through Dr. Crozier to heal Alyssa, and he and his wife powerfully prayed over Alyssa and Terri during their last appointment. We have been so impressed with this doctor's knowledge, dedication, and his spiritual focus in helping Alyssa. Alyssa will also be able to do her stem cell transplant here in the US with this doctor instead of traveling to Germany! WOO! We had hoped she would do the transplant this month, but some toxicity levels have caused a minor setback. However, Alyssa is now on track to receive stem cells, which will greatly expedite her body's ability to heal and fight infection, in Florida in mid to late June! GOD IS GOOD.

Thank you for praying, loving us and walking this path with us. Alyssa and I, along with her parents Ron and Terri, also want to THANK YOU for the financial support you have so selflessly blessed us with as well. Alyssa's treatments so far in 2017 alone have cost upwards of \$50,000 out of pocket! Yet God provided! Alyssa's LuLaRoe clothing business has been an amazing gift from God in her life as well. She loves being able to bless others AND contribute toward her medical bills, with Terri and I acting as her hands and feet as she runs her biz from bed! Still, in the face of these high costs, we are humbled to create a GoFundMe account to continue to raise funds to help pay for her treatments. It will be up & running soon.

Alyssa has DEEPLY missed attending church and being able to participate in activities. We look forward to a time (hopefully SOON), when she can be as involved as she so desperately yearns to be! Most of all, we still ask you to join us in prayers of petition for total healing AND prayers of thanksgiving for this progress as well! We are so thankful we've found a home where we feel so loved. WE LOVE YOU and we love being at Crosstown! Alyssa asked to leave you today with one of her favorite scriptures:

1 Thess. 5:16-18 "Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."
