JOHN 16:5-16

⁵But now I am going to him who sent me, and none of you asks me, 'Where are you going?' ⁶But because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your heart.

⁷Nevertheless, I tell you the truth:
it is to your advantage that I go
away, for if I do not go away, the
Helper will not come to you. But if
I go, I will send him to you. ⁸ And
when he comes, he will convict the
world concerning sin and
righteousness and judgment:

⁹concerning sin, because they do not believe in me; ¹⁰ concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father, and you will see me no longer; ¹¹ concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged. ¹²"I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now.

¹³When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come.

¹⁴He will glorify me, for he will take what is mine and declare it to you.

¹⁵ All that the Father has is mine; therefore I said that he will take what is mine and declare it to you. ¹⁶ "A little while, and you will see me no longer; and again a little while, and you will see me."

The Holy Spirit serves three primary functions

- 1. Helps us recognize our need
for God.**
- 2. Serves as the feeling that
leads people to see Christ.**
- 3. Reminds the World of God's
attitude toward sin.**

Holy Spirit's Personal Presence:

1. The Spirit continues to teach and guide those who follow Christ.
2. The Holy Spirit speaks the words of Your Heavenly Father who Cares Deeply for you.
3. The Holy Spirit uses Scripture, godly counsel, and prayer to communicate to you.

The Hand

1. Thumb: Hearing God's Word
2. Index Finger: Reading God's Word
3. Middle Finger: Studying God's Word
4. Ring Finger: Memorizing God's Word
5. Pinky Finger: Meditating on God's Word
6. Palm: Doing what God's Word Says
