- Lord's Supper
  - 1 Corinthians 11:20-21
  - Participating in an activity that's uniquely the Lord's



# Words Connected with the Lord's Supper

- Thanksgiving
  - Matt. 26:27; Mark 14:23; Luke 22:17; 1 Cor. 11:24 “give thanks”, “the Eucharist”
  - Salvation is God's free gift, and not something we earn or deserve



# Words Connected with the Lord's Supper

- Communion

- 1 Corinthians 10:16-17

- Sharing in Christ's sacrifice and its benefits

- Sharing with one another

# Words Connected with the Lord's Supper

- Memorial

- 1 Corinthians 11:24-25
- We need to remember Christ's death in a personal way
- We're reenacting the event that brings salvation (1 Cor. 11:26)



# Words Connected with the Lord's Supper

- Future Hope

- We proclaim the Lord's death  
“until He comes” (1 Cor. 11:26)
- Proclaim our confidence in  
glorious future

# Words Connected with the Lord's Supper

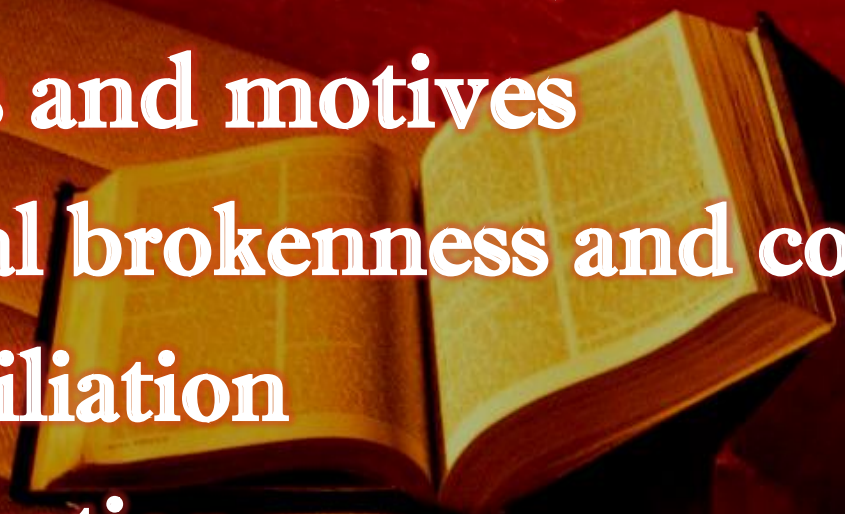
- Covenant

- “Blood of the new covenant”  
(Matt. 26:28; Mark 14:24; Luke 22:20; 1 Cor. 11:25)
- We belong exclusively to the Lord



# Words Connected with Lord's Supper

- Worthy Manner
  - “Examine” ourselves (1 Cor. 11:27-28)
  - Attitudes and motives
    - Spiritual brokenness and confession
    - Reconciliation
    - Rededication
    - Joy
