

## In Layman's Terms with Sean

This Wednesday in the youth class Earl Logan spoke to our kids about the 14 spiritual disciplines, and one of these disciplines Earl put an emphasis of urgency on was accountability. Accountability is an instrumental part of being a Christian, but sadly many times it is something that is not taken advantage of, because to be accountable with people and to rely on them requires an enormous amount of effort. It's not just about being there for each other through all the important moments in life, but it's about being there for each other in the little moments as well. This effort simultaneously requires another difficult part of us, it calls for us to be vulnerable with each other. Talk about hard, talk about worrying what someone will think of you once you have confessed some of your sins and failures to them. At the same time while revealing those things may be hard, it should also be encouraging and uplifting, when that person hears your sins and failures and shows you love instead of judgement. What uplifting and empowering moments these are in our lives when we are able to be 100% honest and truthful with each other, leaving our masks and walls behind to grow together in the Lord.

I meet every week with a group of youth ministers for lunch, and I am so overjoyed and blessed to have a group like this. Where we can talk about our fears, failures, sins, frustrations, victories, joy, happiness, successes. This group is essential to me and my ministry, a sounding board for ideas and encouragement. When I look at this group, I wonder how people make it through life without this, I wonder how we make it through everyday without people we can lean on or can lean on us. The truth is life is much harder without support and love from those who care for you. That is why accountability is such an important part of our spiritual disciplines. I encourage you to find people within the church to be your accountability partners, and to hold yourself accountable to the standards of righteousness.

In my small group we go over 5 questions every week and I want to share those with you because they are very important and powerful:

What has God done in your world for which you can praise Him?

What temptation or challenge to your faith did you face and how did you handle it?

What opportunity to care for someone else and serve did God give you and what did you do?

What relationship in your life is bringing you the most pain or difficulty and what do you think is God's desire in it?

What is the one thing you think God wanted you to learn from your life this last week?
